

CITY & COUNTY CREDIT UNION STUDENT CHECKING ENTER TO WIN CONTEST OFFICIAL RULES

- 1. NO PURCHASE OF ANY KIND IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN THIS CONTEST. MEMBERSHIP IS REQUIRED TO WIN THIS CONTEST.**
- 2. EACH CONTEST ENTRY WILL HAVE AN EQUAL CHANCE OF WINNING.**
- 3. Consumer Disclosure:** Odds of winning are based upon the number of entries.
- 4. Sponsor:** City & County Credit Union ("the Credit Union") is the sponsor of the Contest. The Credit Union's business address is 144 11th Street East, Saint Paul, MN 55101.
- 5. Contest Period:** The Contest starts 8/1/2026 12:00 AM - and ends 9/30/2026 at 11:59 PM ("Contest Period").
- 6. Contest Entries: ONE ENTRY PER PERSON.** Entry will remain eligible through the end of the Contest period. How to submit your entry: 1) Open a new Student Checking Account & 2) Make a minimum \$10 opening deposit within the first 30 days of account opening. No other entry methods permitted.
- 7. Eligibility:** Credit Union employees, employee family members, and officials are not eligible to participate in the Contest. To qualify for the Contest, all entrants must be a member of the Credit Union and enrolled in High School or a Higher Education program. Entering this Contest, entrants accept and agree to be bound by these Official Rules and the decisions of the Credit Union. Contest void where prohibited by law.
- 8. Prize Award:** Three (3) winners will be selected from all entries. The winner selection will be held on 10/13/2026. All eligible entries received by 11:59 PM on 9/30/2026 qualify for the prize drawings. The winners need not be present and will be notified by email. If an entrant's name is selected but they do not respond to claim the prize by 5:00 pm 10/26/2026, then another winner will be selected.
